As you may recall, last August the coalition sent its *Blueprint for Federal Action on Illegal Guns* to the Obama Administration. Today, at the start of a new year, the coalition is releasing it publicly for the first time. The Blueprint, which includes 40 specific proposals for executive branch action to improve the enforcement of *existing* gun laws, was the product of many conversations with coalition mayors' offices, as well as with current and former federal, state and local law enforcement officials.
